

SIND ORDINANCE NO.XVII OF 1984

**THE SIND CO-OPERATIVE SOCIETIES AND CO-OPERATIVE BANKS
(RE-PAYMENT OF LOANS) (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 1984**

[27th September, 1984]

An Ordinance to amend the Sind Co-operative Societies and Co-operative Banks (Re-payment of Loans) Ordinance, 1966.

WHEREAS the Federal Shariat Court has directed to make certain amendment in the Sind Co-operative Societies and Co-operative Banks (Re-payment of Loans) Ordinance, 1966;

Preamble.

AND WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Sind Co-operative Societies and Co-operative Banks (Re-payment of Loans) Ordinance, 1966, in the manner hereinafter appearing;

NOW, THEREFORE, in pursuance of the Proclamation of the fifth day of July 1977, and the Provisional Constitution Order, 1981, the Governor of Sind is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:—

1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the Sind Co-operative Societies and Co-operative Banks (Re-payment of Loans) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1984.

Short title and commencement.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. In the Sind Co-operative Societies and Co-operative Banks (Re-payment of Loans) Ordinance, 1966, in section 8-B, in sub-section (3), the fullstop appearing at the end shall be replaced by a colon and thereafter the following proviso shall be added: —

Amendment of Section 8-B of West Pakistan Ordinance XIV of 1966.

“Provided that no order in appeal shall be passed unless the appellant is afforded an opportunity of being heard.”.
