

SIND ORDINANCE No. LII of 1984

**THE SIND CONSUMPTION OF INTOXICANTS RESTRICTION
(AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 1984**

[10th December, 1984]

An Ordinance to amend the Sind Consumption of Intoxicants Restriction Act, 1940.

WHEREAS the Federal Shariat Court has directed to make certain amendments in the Sind Consumption of Intoxicants Restriction Act, 1940. **Preamble.**

AND WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Sind Consumption of Intoxicants Restriction Act, 1940, in the manner hereinafter appearing;

NOW, THEREFORE, in pursuance of the Proclamation of the fifth day of July, 1977, and the Provisional Constitution Order, 1981, the Governor of Sind is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:-

1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the Sind Consumption of Intoxicant Restriction (Amendment) Ordinance, 1984. **Short title and commencement.**

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. In the Sind Consumption of Intoxicants Restriction Act, 1940, hereinafter referred to as the said Act, in section 2, in subsection (1), in clause (e), the full-stop at the end shall be replaced by a semi colon and thereafter the following clause shall be added:-- **Amendment of section 2 of Sind Act IV of 1940.**

“(f) “consume or consumption” includes taking any intoxicating drug by injection.”.

3. In the said Act, in section 3, section 4 and section 5, for the words “with imprisonment which may extend to seven years or with fine which may extend to one lac rupees or with both”, occurring for the second time, the words “with imprisonment which shall not be less than six months but not more than seven years and with fine which may extend to one lac rupees” shall be substituted. **Amendment of sections 3, 4 and 5 of Sind Act IV of 1940.**
