

SIND ORDINANCE NO. XIII OF 1978

THE COURT FEES (SIND AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 1978

[2nd August, 1978]

An Ordinance to amend the Court Fees Act, 1870, in its application to the Province of Sind.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Court Fees Act, 1870, in its application to the Province of Sind in the manner hereinafter appearing; **Preamble.**

NOW, THEREFORE, in pursuance of the Proclamation of the fifth day of July, 1977, read with the Laws (Continuance in Force) Order, 1977, the Governor of Sind is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance :-

1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the Court Fees (Sind Amendment) Ordinance, 1978. **Short title and commencement.**

(2) It shall come into force at once and be deemed to have taken effect on and from the 1st August, 1978.

2. Notwithstanding anything contained in the Court Fees Act, 1870 (Act VII of 1870), no court fee shall be payable in a criminal case and, a case of civil nature the value of which does not exceed twenty five thousand rupees. **Abolition of Court Fees in certain cases.**
