

**THE DOW UNIVERSITY OF HEALTH SCIENCES (AMENDMENT)
ORDINANCE, 2005.**

[17th September, 2005]

An Ordinance to amend the Dow University of Health Sciences Act, 2004.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Dow University of Health Sciences Act, 2004, in the manner hereinafter appearing; **Preamble.**

AND WHEREAS the Provincial Assembly is not in session and the Governor of Sindh is satisfied that circumstances exist which render it necessary to take immediate action;

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by clause (1) of Article 128 of the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan, the Governor of Sindh is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:-

1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the Dow University of Health Sciences (Amendment) Ordinance, 2005.

Short title, and commencement.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. In the Dow University of Health Sciences Act, 2004, after section 4-A, the following new section shall be inserted:-

[Insertion of section 4-B Sindh Act No. X of 2004.](#)

“4-B (1) Any person transferred to the University under sub-section (2) of section 4 including the person who is transferred but has not so far reported to the University may opt to serve the Health Department.

(2) The option under sub-section (1) shall be exercised and submitted to Government within ninety days of the commencement of the Dow University of Health Sciences (Amendment) Ordinance, 2005 and the option so exercised shall be final.

(3) On receipt of the option under sub-section (2), Government may, transfer or as the case may be, allow to continue, the person concerned for service in the Health Department.”
