

SIND ORDINANCE NO.LXIII OF 1984

THE SIND LIVESTOCK IMPROVEMENT (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 1984

[12th December, 1984]

An Ordinance to amend the Sind Livestock Improvement Act, 1933.

WHEREAS the Federal Shariat Court has directed to make certain amendments in the Sind Livestock Improvement Act, 1933;

Preamble.

AND WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Sind Livestock Improvement Act, 1933, in the manner hereinafter appearing;

NOW, THEREFORE, in pursuance of the Proclamation of the fifth day of July, 1977, and the Provisional Constitution Order, 1981, the Governor of Sind is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:—

1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the Sind Livestock Improvement (Amendment) Ordinance, 1984.

Short title and commencement.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. In the Sind Livestock Improvement Act, 1933, hereafter referred to as the said Act, in section 7, in sub-section (5), the full-stop appearing at the end shall be replaced by a colon and thereafter the following proviso shall be added:—

Amendment of section 7 of Sind Act XXII of 1933.

“Provided that no order of refusal to grant or revocation of a licence shall be passed unless the applicant for the licence or, as the case may be, the person keeping the bull is given an opportunity of being heard.”.

3. In the said Act, in section 22, the full-stop at the end shall be replaced by a colon and thereafter the following proviso shall be added:—

Amendment of section 22 of Sind Act XXII of 1933.

“Provided that no order or proceedings shall be modified, annulled or reversed, unless the person affected is given an opportunity of being heard.”.
