

SIND ORDINANCE NO.I OF 1973
THE WEST PAKISTAN ESSENTIAL SERVICES (MAINTENANCE)
(SIND AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 1973

[13th January, 1973]

An Ordinance to amend the West Pakistan Essential Services (Maintenance) Act, 1958, in its application to the Province of Sind.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the West Pakistan Essential Services (Maintenance) Act, 1958, in its application to the Province of Sind, in the manner hereinafter appearing;

Preamble.

AND WHEREAS the Provincial Assembly of Sind is not in session and the Governor of Sind is satisfied that circumstances exist which render immediate action necessary;

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by clause (1) of Article 135 of the Interim Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan, the Governor of Sind is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance: -

1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the West Pakistan Essential Services (Maintenance) (Sind Amendment) Ordinance, 1973.

Short title and commencement.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. In the West Pakistan Essential Services (Maintenance) Act, 1958, in its application to the Province of Sind, section 3 shall be re-numbered as sub-section (1) of that section and after the sub-section so re-numbered, the following sub-section shall be added, namely:—

Amendment of Section 3 of West Pakistan Act XXXIV of 1958.

“(2) Government may, by notification in the official Gazette, apply this Act to the employment in any autonomous body, including a University, Board of Intermediate and Secondary Education, the Board of Technical Education, or any part thereof.”.
