

SINDH ORDINANCE NO. VII OF 1972

THE WEST PAKISTAN FISHERIES (SIND AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 1972

[20th April, 1972]

An Ordinance to amend the West Pakistan Fisheries Ordinance, 1961, in its application to the Province of Sind.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the West Pakistan Fisheries Ordinance, 1961, in its application to the Province of Sind, in the manner hereinafter appearing. **Preamble**

NOW, THEREFORE, in pursuance of the Martial Law Proclamation of 25th March, 1969, read with the Provisional Constitution Order, and in exercise of all powers enabling him in that behalf, the Governor of Sind and Martial Law Administrator, Zone 'D' is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:-

1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the West Pakistan Fisheries (Sind Amendment) Ordinance, 1972.

Short title and commencement.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. In the West Pakistan Fisheries Ordinance, 1961, in its application to the Province of Sind, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance, for section 4, the following section shall be substituted, namely:-

Substitution of section 4 of West Pakistan Ordinance, XXX of 1961.

Powers of District Council to lease out any water other than private water.

"4. (1) The District Council may, for a period not exceeding three years, lease out, on such conditions as may be prescribed, the right to catch fish in any water other than private water.

(2) Any amount due to Government under the provisions of sub-section (1), and remaining un-paid one month after it has become so due, may be recovered as arrears of land revenue."

3. In section 26 of the Principal Ordinance, in clause (d) of sub-section (2), for the words "Director of Fisheries", the words "District Council" shall be substituted.

Amendment of section 26 of West Pakistan Ordinance XXX of 1961
