

SIND ORDINANCE NO.IV OF 1972
THE WEST PAKISTAN MOTOR VEHICLES (SIND AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 1972

[18th March, 1972]

An Ordinance further to amend the West Pakistan Motor Vehicles Ordinance, 1965, in its application to the Province of Sind.

WHEREAS it is expedient further to amend the West Pakistan Motor Vehicles Ordinance, 1965, in its application to the Province of Sind, in the manner hereinafter appearing;

Preamble.

NOW, THEREFORE, in pursuance of the Martial Law Proclamation of 25th March, 1969, read with the Provisional Constitution Order, and in exercise of all powers enabling him in that behalf, the Governor of Sind and Martial Law Administrator, Zone 'D' is please to make and promulgate the following Ordinance: -

1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the West Pakistan Motor Vehicles (Sind Amendment) Ordinance, 1972.

Short title and commencement.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. In the West Pakistan Motor Vehicles Ordinance, 1965, in its application to the Province of Sind, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance, in section 49, for clause (b) of sub-section (2), the following clause shall be substituted, namely:—

Amendment of section 49 of West Pakistan Ordinance XIX of 1965.

“(b) any other stage carriage permit if—

- (i) the applicant furnishes a guarantee in the prescribed form duly issued, by the West Pakistan Transporters Mutual Assistance Co-operative Society Limited, Lahore or by the Sind Bus Owners Co-operative Society Limited, Hyderabad;
- (ii) the guarantee so issued remains valid; and
- (iii) such guarantee is not withdrawn; or

(iv) the applicant furnishes security to the satisfaction of the Chairman of the Regional Transport Authority, to which the application is made, for payment of any compensation that the applicant may be required to pay under the provisions of section 67.”.

3. In section 70 of the Principal Ordinance, after sub-section (7), the following new sub-section shall be inserted, namely:—

“(7-A) All persons employed for the purpose of the Corporation shall be deemed, during the period of such employment to be public servants within the meaning of section 21 of the Pakistan penal Code (Act XLV of 1860).”.
