

SINDH ORDINANCE NO.XIV OF 1974

THE WEST PAKISTAN MOTOR VEHICLES (SIND AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 1974

[4th September, 1974]

An Ordinance further to amend the West Pakistan Motor Vehicles Ordinance, 1965, in its application to the Province of Sind.

WHEREAS it is expedient further to amend the West Pakistan Motor Vehicles Ordinance, 1965, in its application to the Province of Sind, in the manner hereinafter appearing;

AND WHEREAS The Provincial Assembly is not in session and the Governor of Sind is satisfied that circumstances exist which render it necessary to take immediate action;

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by clause (1) of Article 128 of the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan, the Governor of Sind is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:-

1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the West Pakistan Motor Vehicles (Sind Amendment) Ordinance, 1974.

Short title and commencement.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. In the West Pakistan Motor Vehicles Ordinance, 1965, in its application to the Province of Sind, the note at the end of the Sixth Schedule shall be numbered as "Note 1", the following shall be added as note 2:-

Amendment of the Sixth Schedule to West Pakistan Ordinance XIX of 1965.

"Note: 2. In the case of Karachi District when all the series from 'A' to 'Z' under note 1 are exhausted, new group of letters shall be used as the registration mark in the following orders:-

KCC for private cars.

KCJ for jeep.

KCS for station wagons and other similar vehicles.

KCB for buses.

KCT for trucks

KCX for taxis.

KCY for scooters and motorcycles.

KCR for motorcycle rickshaws.

KCM for miscellaneous vehicles (tractors/cranes).
