NOTIFICATION

No.SOR-III(S&GAD)1-19/2008(P).- In exercise of the powers conferred under section 23 of the Punjab Civil Servants Act 1974 (VIII of 1974), Governor of the Punjab is pleased to make the following rules:

- 1. Short title and commencement.**- (1) These rules may be cited as the Punjab Building Research Stations and Quality Control Cell Service Rules 2016.
(2) They shall come into force at once.
- 2. Method of recruitment.**- The method of recruitment, minimum qualification, age limit and other incidental matters for the posts of the functional unit shall be such as given in the Schedule appended to these rules.
- 3. Repeal.**- The Punjab Building Research Station (Research Posts) Recruitment Rules 1979 and the Punjab Buildings Department (Quality Control Cells) Service Rules 1981 are hereby repealed.
